They allowed the fund to head into an election season with the funding in jeopardy.

Mainers were upset that will of voters was **deliberately ignored within the halls of power**. Naturally, they begin to believe that our government is not listening to us.

Cynicism and apathy are tenacious co-conspirators. They thrive by attacking people's motivation to participate in civic life. They succeed by preying on fear and promoting negative public discourse. Cynicism and apathy succeed when we believe that we, the people, cannot do anything to change the status quo.

But, we are fortunate; we have the antidote to cynicism and apathy. You. People who speak out and stand up to those in power, who recruit more people, and who engage in direct action to make change possible. Our message is one of hope, that anything is possible when we work together.

So, we will continue to identify people harmfully affected by the influence of big money so they can share their story in **an inspiring way**. We will organize people who put **our community values in motion** to create change.

And by harnessing the powerful energy of grassroots citizens in action toward a common goal, we will empower everyday citizens to take back control of our government.

What I said to my board president, and to you today is this: the 'movement' already resides in all of us.
